At glory's throne, made pure;

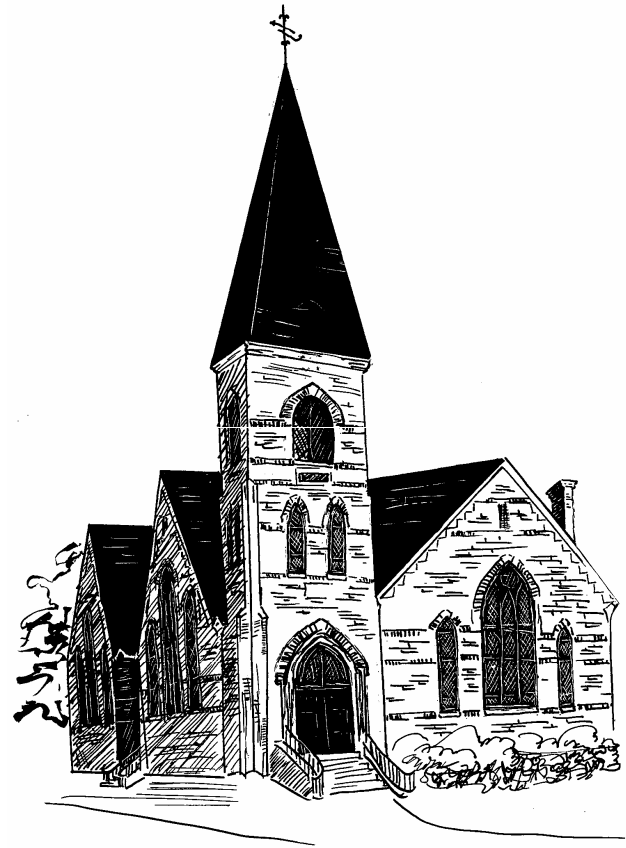
